

ELLCGA SPRING MEETING AND CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019 at LONGNIDDRY GC

- The format of the Spring Meeting on Tuesday 30 April is stroke play. The top 16 scratch scores qualify for the knock-out stages of the County Championship, to be played at Longniddry on Sunday 5 and Monday 6 May. The best 8 nett scores of the remaining players will qualify for the knock-out stages for the Handicap Quaich, to be played at Longniddry on Sunday 5 and Monday 6 May.
- All players will be asked to indicate on their score cards their availability for the knock-out rounds. Players who qualify for the knock-out rounds will be notified individually as soon as possible, hopefully on Wednesday 1 May.
- All scores on 30 April will be returned to members' home clubs. In the event that you are unable to complete a hole and will be submitting a 'no return' (NR) for the competition, *please continue to record your scores for the remaining holes* as this is required for handicapping purposes.
- Parking is beside the clubhouse, with an overflow area also available.
- Please arrive in good time for your tee time and collect your card from the registration desk in the clubhouse. Cards should be returned to the registration desk at the end of your round.
- Normal rules apply re dress in the clubhouse.
- There is a small locker room upstairs in the clubhouse, but unfortunately the shower is currently out of order. There are spare holdall lockers – keys are available from the office on payment of a £5 deposit.
- There is a practice area (short game and shots up to 180 yards – provide own balls) and practice putting green.
- Stroke savers, trolleys, balls etc are all available from the Pro Shop which is close to the first tee.
- There are 150 yard markers (to middle of green) on the course. Flag colours indicate pin positions: white (back); yellow (middle); red (front).
- There is an on-course toilet as you walk from the 10th to the 11th hole. The code is 5823.
- Catering is available from 7.30 am. A full menu, including daily specials, sandwiches and toasties will be available until 5.30 pm. Players who will return to the clubhouse after 5.30pm and would like some sandwiches to be left should speak to the bar staff before playing.
- The CSS for the day will be posted on the ELLCGA websites and all scores will be returned to home CDHs.
- Mobile phones should not be used for making or receiving calls in clubhouse and should be on silent mode.
- There will be a voluntary twos sweep - £1 per person.
- Presentation to the County Champion and Handicap Quaich winner will take place in Longniddry Clubhouse following completion of the Championship Final.
