

## **ELLCGA Commonwealth Spoons at Musselburgh GC on 20 May 2021**

### **Additional Notes**

#### Arrival

1. Please ensure that you have read the latest Scottish Golf Covid-19 Guidance, which can be found <https://scottishgolf.org/covid-19-update-23-april-2021/>.
2. Please change your shoes etc. in your car: the locker rooms are available only for access to toilets. A face mask should be worn in the clubhouse.
3. Please check in at desk to the left of the clubhouse entrance.
4. When you check in you will be asked to confirm that you have read all the guidance and requirements, and that you do not have any symptoms of Covid-19. If you have any symptoms you will not be permitted to play, so please do not come to Musselburgh. We will have a forehead thermometer on site to temperature test if required.
5. You will be asked to report your current Handicap Index. Your foursomes handicap will be 50% of your combined course handicaps.
6. Cards will be given out at check-in

#### Play

7. Please put your team's names in against 'Player A' and record your team's score as 'Score A'. Please record the score for your playing partners as 'Score B'. Please put the name of the players whose score you have recorded in the 'Player B' box.
8. Play is from the red tees. The format is foursomes, stroke play.
9. Please observe social distancing at all times on the course and in the clubhouse.
10. Preferred lies may be taken in all bunkers (within six inches, not nearer the hole).
11. Please do not touch or remove flagsticks.
12. On completion of the round, please cross check scores and then sign your own card.
13. Please note that the course will also be open for members' play during times when we are not using it.
14. Please note that there are no on-course toilets at Musselburgh.

#### Submitting Scores

15. You will be asked to read out your scores to County Officers, who will write them down on a master sheet. You should then place your card in the carrier bag where it will be 'quarantined'. Please wear a mask while reporting your score.

16. We expect to be sending four teams forward to the national finals of the Commonwealth Spoons which will be held at Dullatur GC (Cumbernauld) on Monday 30 August. The teams with the best net scores will be asked to confirm their availability.

#### Clubhouse and Catering

17. Catering is available in the clubhouse, with indoor seating as per the Covid rules in force on the day. There is outside seating for up to 32 people. Tea/coffee and tray-bakes will be available from 0900, and light lunch/hot rolls/soup available from 1200.

18. The clubhouse closes at 8.00pm. If the clubhouse has closed by the time you come in, there is a public toilet at the petrol station on the A1 roundabout.
